

## Manually Configuring Mac OS X 10.5 for Wireless PittNet

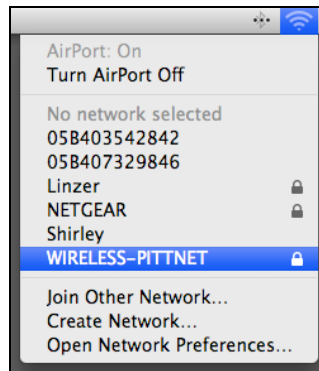
### Overview

Use the following instructions to manually configure Mac OS X 10.5 (Leopard) to use Wireless PittNet, the University of Pittsburgh's campus-wide wireless network. For a complete list of wireless locations, visit [wireless.pitt.edu](http://wireless.pitt.edu).

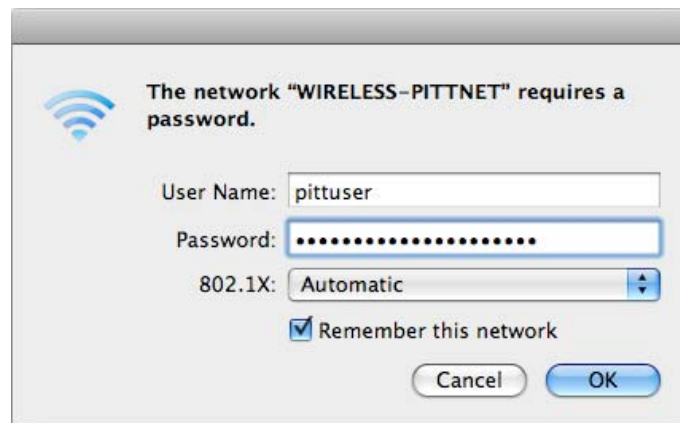
Please note the *PittNet Complete* CD does not currently configure Leopard to use the University's wired or wireless networks. The *PittNet Complete* CD can be used to configure Mac OS X 10.3 and 10.4.

### Configuring Mac OS X 10.5

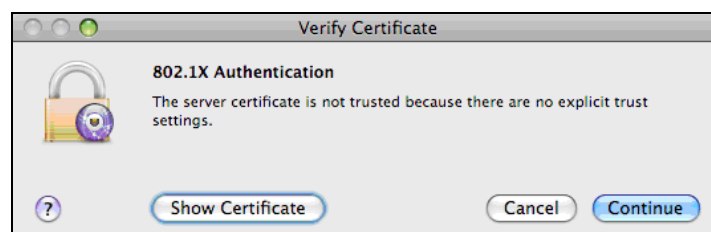
1. In the AirPort Status menu, select **WIRELESS-PITNET**. This option will only be present if you are in an area with Wireless PittNet coverage.



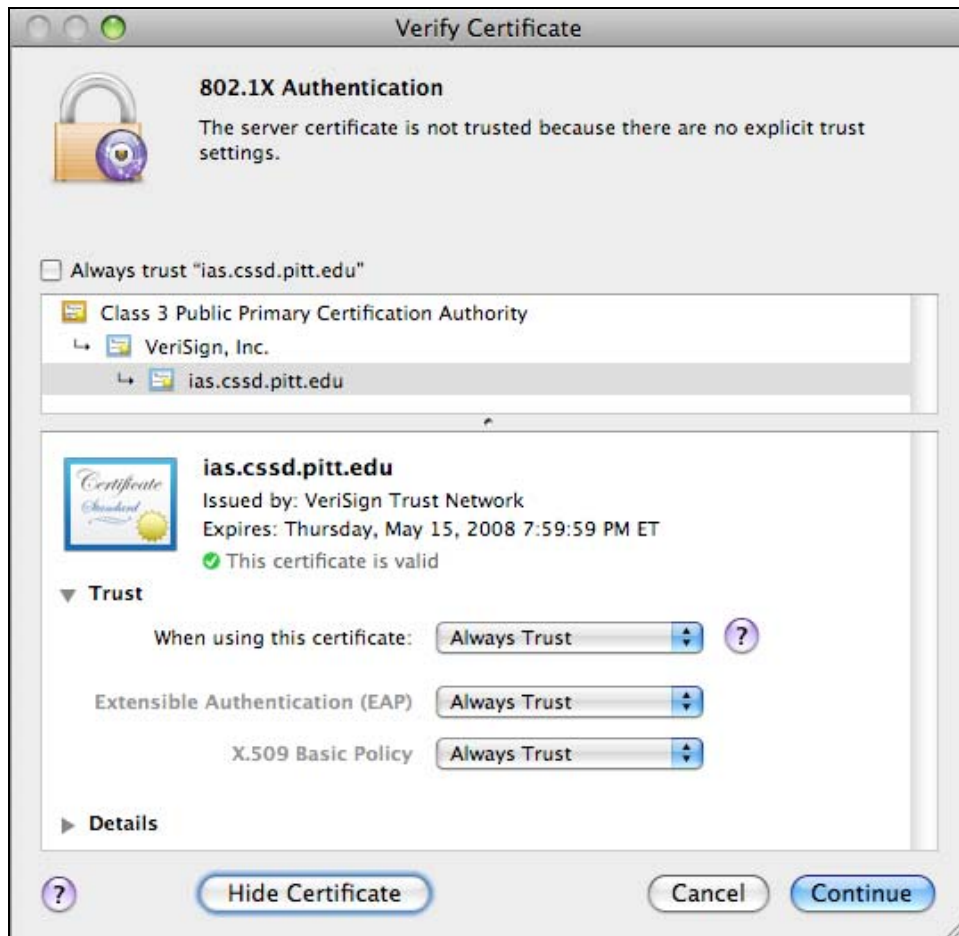
2. When prompted, enter your University Computer Account username and password in the boxes provided. Click **OK**.



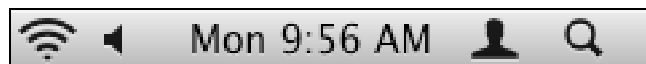
3. In the Verify Certificate window, click **Show Certificate**.



4. Click the triangle next to *Details* to expand it. In the *When using this certificate...* pull-down menu, select **Always Trust**. Click **Continue**.



5. You should now be connected to Wireless PittNet. To connect in the future, simply select **WIRELESS-PITTNET** from the AirPort status menu. You will be connected when the icon changes from gray to black.
