

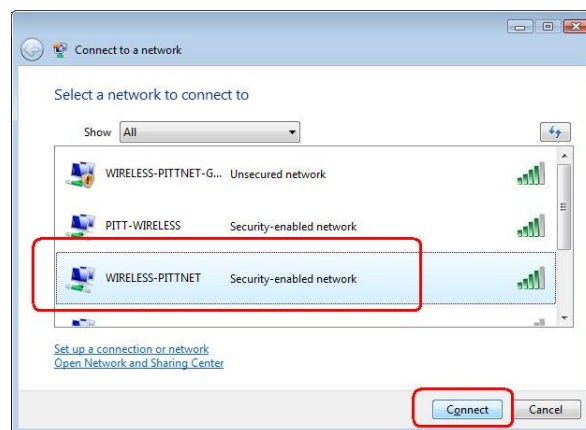
Manually Configuring Windows Vista for Wireless PittNet

Overview

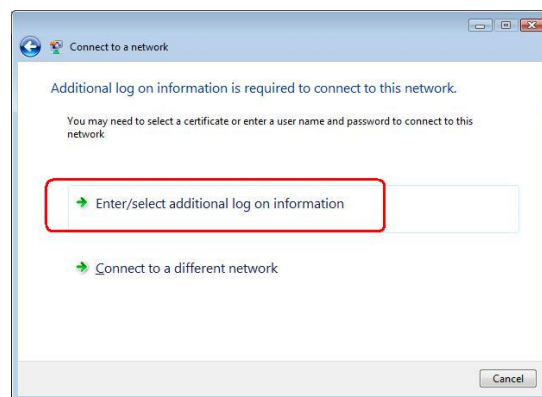
The University of Pittsburgh's Wireless PittNet service provides wireless network access to all University of Pittsburgh students, faculty, and staff. You can use the *PittNet Complete* CD (available at any campus computing lab or 105 Bellefield Hall) to automatically configure your Windows Vista computer to use Wireless PittNet, or you can use the instructions provided below to manually configure your Windows Vista computer.

Configuring Windows Vista

1. Click the **Start** button, and then click **Connect To**. Windows Vista will scan the network and provide you with a list of all available wireless networks.
2. Select **WIRELESS-PITTNET**, and click **Connect**.



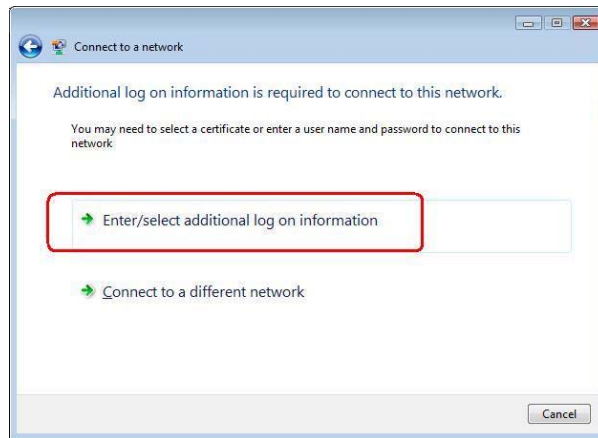
3. At the **Additional log on information is required to connect to this network** window, click **Enter/select additional log on information**.



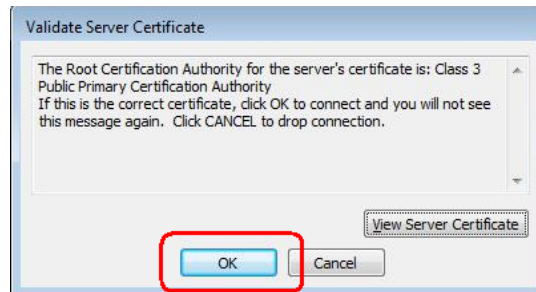
4. In the **Enter Credentials** window, enter your University Computer Account user name and password. Leave the Logon domain box empty. Click **OK**.



5. Another prompt for additional information will appear. Click the **Enter/select additional log on information** button.



6. At the **Validate Server Certificate** window, click **OK**.



7. When the screen appears saying a connection to WIRELESS-PITNET is successful, click **Close**. You can now open a Web browser to begin using the service.
